

Privacy Policy:

Introduction

At ApplyUpp, we respect your privacy and are committed to protecting your personal information. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and disclose your personal information when you use the ApplyUpp website and services (the "Services").

What personal information do we collect?

We collect the following personal information from you when you create an account on ApplyUpp:

Email address

School name

Physical Address

College application information

We may also collect other personal information from you, such as your contact information, demographic information, high school information, college information, and academic information.

How do we use your personal information?

We use your personal information to provide you with the Services, such as helping you to create and submit college applications, request transcripts and letters of recommendation, and track your application status. We also use your personal information to send you promotional emails about our Services and to improve our Services.

How do we disclose your personal information?

We do not sell or share your personal information with third parties for their marketing purposes without your consent. We may share your personal information with third parties for the following purposes:

To provide you with the Services, such as viewing profiles of students and collaborators.

To improve our Services, such as to analyze your usage data and provide you with personalized recommendations

To comply with legal requirements, such as to respond to a court order or subpoena

How do we protect your personal information?

We take reasonable steps to protect your personal information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. We use a variety of security measures, such as encryption and access controls, to protect your personal information.

Your choices

You have the following choices regarding your personal information:

No Plagiarism Policy

This No Plagiarism Policy (the "Policy") is an agreement between ApplyUpp LLC (the "Company") and any person who uses the Applyupp.com website (the "User").

1. Definitions

For purposes of this Policy, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

"Content" means any text, images, code, or other creative material that is published on the Company's website.

"Original Work" means any Content that is created by the User and is not copied from any other source.

"Plagiarism" means the act of copying someone else's work and passing it off as your own.

2. Prohibition of Plagiarism

The User agrees that they will not plagiarize any Content on the Company's website. This includes, but is not limited to, copying text, images, code, or any other type of creative content from other websites, books, articles, or other sources without proper attribution. Students applying to college should never plagiarize any information they see on our site.

3. Consequences of Plagiarism

If the Company discovers that a User has plagiarized Content on the Company's website, the Company may take the following actions:

Notify admissions officers that the user's applications may be plagiarized.

Remove the plagiarized Content from the Company's website.

Notify the User of the plagiarism and give them a chance to explain themselves.

Ban the User from using the Company's website in the future.

Report the plagiarism to the copyright holder of the original work.

Take legal action against the User.

4. Governing Law

This Policy shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas.

5. Entire Agreement

This Policy constitutes the entire agreement between the Company and the User with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous communications, representations, or agreements, whether oral or written.

6. Severability

If any provision of this Policy is held to be invalid or unenforceable, such provision shall be struck from this Policy and the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

7. Waiver

No waiver of any provision of this Policy shall be effective unless in writing and signed by both the Company and the User.

8. Notices

All notices and other communications under this Policy shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly given when delivered in person, upon the first business day following deposit in the United States mail, postage prepaid, certified or registered, return receipt requested, addressed as follows:
